

Request For Proposal

The Navajo Nation's Abandoned Mine Lands (Navajo AML) Reclamation Department is requesting for proposals from qualified Entities to conduct assessment on selected Coal Outcrop (subsurface) Fires. Original Proposal documents should be clearly marked, "Navajo AML Coal Fire Assessments." We will require the proposal in two envelopes; one with the actual proposal and the other with the cost proposal. Submittals are due no later than 4 p.m. (local time) on April 3, 2014 at the Navajo AML – Shiprock AML Field office, 1 Uranium Blvd., Shiprock, NM 87420.

The Coal Fire Assessments will be comprised of three (3) locations exhibiting variable conditions and levels of Fires, within the Chapters of Coyote Canyon, White Rock and Black Mesa. Navajo AML requires the implementation of subsurface assessment without drilling or excavation to determine the status of the coal fires. Technologies such as magnetometry are desired for the underground coal fire assessments.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be scheduled for March 24, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. (local time), Shiprock AML Field Office. Copies of the Proposal Requirements will be made available at that time. A full orientation will be conducted. Failure to attend the entire meeting will result in the rejection of the proposal.
