

## **Request For Proposal**

The Navajo Nation's Abandoned Mine Lands (Navajo AML) Reclamation Department is requesting for proposals from qualified Geotechnical Entities on the evaluation of old underground mining activities at the Coal Mine Mesa Mine site. All original Proposal documents should be clearly marked in a packaged envelope entitled, "Navajo AML Coal Mine Mesa Evaluation." All submittals are due no later than 4 p.m. (local time) on April 10, 2014 at the Navajo AML – Shiprock AML Field office, 1 Uranium Blvd., Shiprock, NM 87420.

The Coal Mine Mesa evaluation will comprised of one (1) former underground mine complex, within the Coal Mine Canyon Chapter, Western Agency, Arizona. A full characterization of the underground mine site and extent will be required with recommendations to stabilize the area for post-mining land use.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be scheduled for April 2, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. (local time), Tuba City AML Field Office. Copies of the Proposal Requirements will be made available at that time. A full orientation will be conducted. Failure to attend the entire meeting will result in the rejection of the proposal.
