

Request For Proposal

The Navajo Nation's Abandoned Mine Lands (Navajo AML) Reclamation Department is requesting for proposals from qualified Computer and Network Entities to set-up and maintain our department's network system. Original Proposal documents should be clearly marked, "Navajo AML Computers and Network system." We will require the proposal in two envelopes; one with the scope-of-work proposal and the other with the cost proposal. Submittals are due no later than 4 p.m. (local time) on March 27, 2014 at the Navajo AML – Shiprock AML Field office, 1 Uranium Blvd., Shiprock, NM 87420.

Navajo AML has an internal Wide-Area-Network (WAN) with offices in Window Rock and Tuba City, Arizona and Shiprock, New Mexico. External communication includes local, tribal, state and federal entities. Software includes variable administrative to technical. Your proposal will be to evaluate the existing network, perform upgrades to the system, upgrades to computers, and perform any other network and computer maintenance as necessary.

A mandatory pre-proposal meeting will be scheduled for March 20, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. (local time), Shiprock AML Field Office. Copies of the Proposal Requirements will be made available at that time. A full orientation will be conducted. Failure to attend the entire meeting will result in the rejection of the proposal.
